

Paul M. LeBreton, Q.C.

Paul M. LeBreton, Q.C. was appointed Chairperson of the Appeals Tribunal of the Workplace Health, Safety and Compensation Commission in February 2001.

From 1998 he was Deputy Minister for the Department of Health and Wellness, and from 1988 to 1998 the Deputy Attorney General and Deputy Minister of Justice for the Province of New Brunswick.



Mr. LeBreton is a graduate of the University of New Brunswick Law School (1972) and the Université de Moncton (1968) with a Bachelor of Arts in Chemistry.

Admitted to the New Brunswick Bar in 1972, Mr. LeBreton was a partner with the Moncton law firm of Landry, LeBreton & McIntyre and area Director for Legal Aid New Brunswick until 1981.

From 1981 to 1988, Mr. LeBreton was Secretary of the Law Society of New Brunswick, Treasurer and Claims Administrator for the Professional Liability Reserve Fund, and vice-chairman of the Canadian Lawyers Insurance Association.

He is currently the Chair of the Council of Canadian Administrative Tribunals.
